MERA CONTINUALLY STRIVES FOR CONSISTENT COMMUNICATIONS

This month we continue to implement our email communications plan as we work towards full email delivery of MERA communications. What do you need to do? Well, open the email, of course, but it is also very important to know which group you are in. Are you Group 1, 2, 3 or 4? Maybe you are in Group 5? (Hint: Everyone is in Group 5!)

- Group 1 Beginning in July, most MERA members received both an email version and a hard copy mailing of MERA's communications. The email version contains images that you "click on" to take you to the different components of the mailing (Hometown News, flyers, program information, etc.). Be sure to check out the email version and let us know what you think! We originally planned to phase in electronic delivery and send members both an email and a hardcopy version through the end of 2022. However, FirstEnergy has withdrawn its support of MERA mailings effective immediately. Consequently, hardcopy mailings via USPS have been discontinued as of October unless we do not have your email address (see Group 4).
- **Group 2** Beginning in July, if you are one of the 78 members who helped us to test and perfect our email communications, you receive **only** the email version.
- **Group 3** Beginning in July, if you joined MERA since January 2022, you receive **only** the email version.
- **Group 4** If you are a MERA member who does *not* have an email address, you have not been left out! We will continue to prepare and send hard copy versions of the MERA mailing via US Mail to this group of members.
- Group 5 Regular communication to every MERA member is very important to the MERA Board and leaders. We are working hard to maintain quality communications despite the many changes to our existing communications systems. But we need your help! If you've got email...watch for emails from MERABERKS and open them! (And, check your spam filter if you aren't receiving MERA emails!) Using email to deliver MERA's monthly communications is more flexible, timelier, and in color!
